Code of Conduct for Christian Education/High 5 Students

To establish an ordered, respectful environment conducive to Christian education and appropriate to First American Lutheran Church the following rules must be followed by students of all ages.

1. Students are welcome to arrive at the church between 5:30 p.m. and 5:55 p.m. on Wednesday evenings, and must gather in the gymnasium whether or not they are partaking in the meal. The meal will be served between 5:30 and 5:50 p.m. During meal time students may quietly visit with one another until their teachers lead them to their respective classrooms.
2. The only option to #1 above is for students to do regular school homework in the designated classroom. Running in the halls, playing in the sanctuary or engaging in any general rowdiness in the church is not permitted at any time.
3. Between 5:55 and 6:00 p.m. teachers will lead their students in an orderly fashion from the gymnasium or homework room to their classrooms.
4. Cell phones in the possession of students must be turned off after 5:55 p.m. and not turned back on until class and/or Chapel is over.
5. Individual Christian education teachers may establish additional rules appropriate to their classes.
