

# FALC 2010 MISSION TRIP AT THE NASHVILLE RESCUE MISSION

It is anticipated that the total cost for the trip will be approximately \$ 450.00. This will be dependent on variables such as transportation costs; donations received and trip sightseeing plans and could increase slightly. During the week your child is on the mission trip they may be photographed or video taped for promotional materials. Please indicate below if this is not acceptable.

**Due to van seating limitations, the maximum number of youth spaces that are available is 18. The final participant list will be determined based on the order that the registrations are received. First American Lutheran Church Youth will receive first priority for available spaces. Other participants will be selected based on the date the registration form and deposit are received.**

## **REFUNDS**

**Prior to January 1, 2010** cancellations will be allowed and requests must be received by Brad Weber in writing. Refunds are limited to the amount paid. When the Youth Organization is properly notified, you will be under no further financial obligations for the trip.

**After January 1, 2010** cancellations are not allowed and you are financially responsible for the entire cost of the trip. No deposits will be refunded.

Chaperones for the trip will be determined by the Youth Board based on the number of participants registered for the trip. Chaperones will be notified in writing by Brad Weber as soon as the final trip roster is determined.

Greetings High School Youth and Parents:

I am pleased to announce that the plans for this year's mission trip have been finalized and once again we are going to try something different. Because it is early in the planning process many of the specific details and trip costs (such as gas pricing, meal costs and additional sight-seeing) have yet to be fully determined, but the cost estimate should be very close.

This year's trip will be a week-long servant event located in the heart of Nashville at the Nashville Rescue Mission and the Second Harvest of Mid Tennessee. Once we arrive in Nashville we will split into 4 different ministry teams and we will rotate assignments through-out the work week so that all youth will be able to experience different ministry opportunities.

### **Our Ministry at the Nashville Rescue Mission**

Three teams will work at the mission on each day.

- Team 1** Will work from 4:30 am to 3:00 pm for the breakfast and lunch meal preparation and serving.
- Team 2** Will work from 10:00 am to 7:00 pm at the warehouse and dinner meal preparation and serving at the mission
- Team 3** Will be assigned to the Nashville Rescue Mission women's shelter. Placement on this team will be limited to female participants.

### **Our Ministry at the Second Harvest Food Bank**

- Team 4** Will work from 8:30 am to 3:00 pm in the warehouse sorting and gleaning food for distribution to local food banks.

During our ministry week we will be housed in a local Wingate Hotel close to the Nashville airport. All meals will be at the Rescue Mission.

When not working at one of the ministry sites nightly sight-seeing adventures will be planned along with free time and pool sitting.
